Acting Center Director Colleen Wilson currently oversees the nationwide development and coordination of Outreach Education for the organization. Working out of National Headquarters in Louisville, Kentucky, Wilson is charged with advancing initiatives and collaborations that provide community resources for educational institutions. She incorporates both the SAR Museum and Genealogical Research Library in program development. Over 10,000 students have participated in curriculum based programs.

As an Associate Museum Director from Chicago, Illinois, Wilson has authored K-12 education programs that received national and state awards. She has been a featured speaker at the national conventions for the American Association for State and Local History, Illinois State Historical Society, and the Annual Chicago's Teacher Resource Fair at Navy Pier. She served as a Finals Judge for the American Legion's National Orations Contest. Her most recent project was the successful implementation of a private grant that provided professional development to teachers from under served counties in eastern Kentucky and full day programming for over 1,000 students.
